

NMCOA 2017 Monte Nationals - Classes/Guidelines

Something for Everyone... Judged and Non-Judged...

YOU MUST HAVE A FIRE EXTINGUISHER TO BE ON THE SHOWFIELD

The fire extinguisher must be visible in/with your Monte, UL approved or equivalent, and fully charged.
The extinguisher need not be permanently mounted, but must be clearly visible and readily available.

Classes 1-9 Will Be Judged

There will be **AT LEAST 3 AWARDS** per class.

The Judges will be judging all parts of the Montes. The undercarriage will only be judged as a tie-breaker if necessary.

Class 1. 70-72	Any Model from 1970 - 1972
Class 2. 73-77	Any Model from 1973 - 1977
Class 3. 78-88 Non SS	Any Non SS Model from 1978 - 1988
Class 4. 95-07 Non SS	Any Non SS Model from 1995 - 2007
Class 5. 83-85 SS	Any SS Model from 1983 - 1985
Class 6. 86-88 SS	Any SS Model from 1986 - 1988
Class 7. 86-87 Aerocoupe	All Aerocoupe Models from 1986 - 1987
Class 8. 00-03 SS	Any SS Model from 2000 - 2003
Class 9. 04-07 SS	Any SS Model from 2004 - 2007

Classes 10-11 Will Be Judged

The Judges will be judging all parts of the Montes. The undercarriage will be judged.

There will be up to 7 AWARDS available and split between Class 10 & Class 11.

Class 10. Gold Class	Any Model from 1970 to 2007
Class 11. Gold Class "Award Of Excellence"	Any Prior "Gold Class Winner"
Class 12. "Award Of Excellence" - "Display"	Any Prior "Award Of Excellence" Winner <u>(Must Pre-Register Before May 1st)</u>

Class 13 - Park & Party - No Judging, No Awards

If Registration is paid/postmarked by May 1, 2017 - You will receive a "Participation Award."

Class 13. Park & Party	Any Condition, Any Year, Any Model 1970 - 2007
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Gold Class Award Of Excellence Guidelines

Upon winning a GOLD CLASS award, the vehicle (owner) received a GOLD CLASS plaque/trophy and a GOLD CLASS WINNER badge. The badge provided was to be properly/permanently affixed to the vehicle. The preferred mounting location is on the front grill, but in all cases, it must be easily seen by the general public. The badge indicates that the vehicle is a NMCOA GOLD CLASS WINNER.

All prior GOLD CLASS winning vehicles that have properly/permanently affixed the GOLD CLASS WINNER badge to the vehicle will now be eligible to compete and be judged in the GOLD CLASS "AWARD OF EXCELLENCE" class.

In addition to the GOLD CLASS plaque/trophy, the GOLD CLASS "AWARD OF EXCELLENCE" winning vehicle will receive an "AWARD OF EXCELLENCE" TAB which is designed to be properly/permanently affixed behind the GOLD CLASS WINNER badge.

All prior AWARD OF EXCELLENCE winning vehicles that have properly/permanently affixed the GOLD CLASS WINNER and the "AWARD OF EXCELLENCE" badges to the vehicle MAY once again compete and be judged in the GOLD CLASS "AWARD OF EXCELLENCE" class. All prior AWARD OF EXCELLENCE winning vehicles are NOT permitted to compete in the "GOLD CLASS".

The GOLD CLASS WINNER badge and the GOLD CLASS "AWARD OF EXCELLENCE" tab will only be awarded once to a Monte/owner. GOLD CLASS plaques/trophies will continue to be awarded for each win in either class.

The GOLD CLASS WINNER badge and the GOLD CLASS "AWARD OF EXCELLENCE" tab must be properly displayed at all subsequent NMCOA events.

Gold Class Award Of Excellence - "Display" Guidelines

All prior AWARD OF EXCELLENCE winning vehicles that have properly/permanently affixed the GOLD CLASS WINNER and the "AWARD OF EXCELLENCE" badges to the vehicle MAY enter the GOLD CLASS "AWARD OF EXCELLENCE"-"DISPLAY" class. This class will be "DISPLAY" only. It will not be judged (except for special awards). All participants will be automatically awarded a GOLD CLASS plaque/trophy at the awards ceremony. The Monte will still be eligible for the Special Awards. All participants in this class MUST pre-register and indicate that they are going into this class by the May 1st deadline to be eligible. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Special Awards

6-People's Choice Awards, 1-Children's Choice Award, 1-Ernie Oldani Extra Effort Award (Non Trailered Monte Only),
1-Best Engineered Award, 1-Attention To Detail Award (Class 12 Only),
1-Best of Show Award

Owners will be responsible for Class selection during the registration process. Once the owner has selected a class, you CANNOT Re-Classify after the June 1st deadline. The show staff reserves the right to Re-Classify a Monte that is in the wrong class as per class guidelines in Classes 1-12.
